Budget Planning

Tim asked all committee chairs to take a good look at the budget and submit their plans and proposals for next year's budget. This year, our budget was \$49,000 and we only earned \$44,000. The projects budget looks like there is a surplus of \$15,000. However \$6,000 of that figure is committed for scholarships. He cautioned the club to be careful in starting new SLP's and how we are spending our money. He asked all committee chairs to get their proposed budget items to him ASAP. The budget committee will be meeting in the next 2-3 weeks to complete the budget process for next year.
