Know A Visiting Kiwanian, Chris Reardon

Chris Reardon from Dover-Foxcross, Maine, was our speaker today. He moved from the San Diego area to a small town, Dover-Foxcross, in the center of Maine. He works for the Department of Commerce and Homeland Security mapping and surveying the remote land between the US and Canadian border. He is visiting in the area and graciously spoke about his home and Kiwanis Club in Maine. He lives in a 9,000 feet Grange Hall that has three floors. One houses a food bank, one is his living space and one is unfurnished. His Kiwanis Club is the main volunteer group for the town that has 78 members. It meets at 6:30 AM for breakfast and is the largest Kiwanis Club in Northern Maine. The Club has two main fundraisers: the River Race that raised about \$16,000 and a yearly auction that raises about \$14,000. Their Club conducts business much as we do except they sing both the Canadian and US anthem at the beginning of the meetings.
