Know A Visiting Kiwanian, Dennis Crane

His father was "big into" the AFL-CIO working in a steel rolling mill. He remembered his dad working in segments of 20 minutes to be relieved of the hot conditions where raw steel was poured in the steel mill. As a kid, Dennis worked many odd jobs from lawn care to grocery store, to bowling alley setting the pins to bar/restaurants. He first taught in Zion, IL before moving to Corona to teach at Coronita. He taught or was in administration for over 40 years. He was the first in his family to get a college education. Dennis has loved working with Kiwanis because of his loyalty to children and the community.
