**WELCOME TO DAVID BRISTOW, RIVERSIDE FEDERAL MAGISTRATE JUDGE.** Judge Bristow, formerly with Reid & Hellyer, was appointed to the bench for an eight-year term about one year ago. A Riverside native, Bristow is a graduate of La Sierra High School and received a BA from Cal State San Bernardino in 1985. He earned his law degree from University of the Pacific's Mc George School of Law in 1993 and passed the bar that same year. Before his private legal practice, he was a Deputy District Attorney for San Bernardino County from 1994-96 and a Deputy Public Defender for the same County from 1996-97. Bristow lives in Riverside with his wife Kristen and their two small children. Judges are people, too. It will be fun to interrelate with one without that black robe on.

**THANKS TO BOB HARTNETT, Public Affairs, Inland Empire Social Security.** Mr. Hartnett, who has worked for Social Security for 38 years was a very knowledgeable and entertaining speaker, briefing us on at least six common myths about Social Security. He noted that the program is for much more than just retirement. About 1/3 of the population needs Social Security for reasons (such as disability) long before retirement. He further stressed that it is only a supplement for retirement, not an entire retirement plan. Yet some 20% of recipients have no other income. And for nearly 2/3 of the recipients, this represents about half their total income during retirement. About 1 out of 5 Americans is on Social Security, some 53,000,000 people. The plan is fully funded through 2037. He urged us to visit their award winning web site [www.socialsecurity.gov](http://www.socialsecurity.gov) to get more information about the plan.

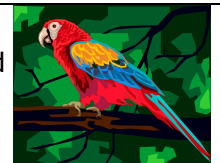
